

What is Osteoarthritis?

Osteoarthritis (OA) is an irreversible condition where the cartilage in your horse's joints wears down. Initially, inflammation causes pain, stiffness, and swelling, which can lead to cartilage breakdown and permanent bone changes visible on x-ray.

OA can develop in any horse but is more common in older and performance horses. Other factors like genetics, being overweight, or prolonged inflammation can speed up its progression.

Managing OA relies on recognition of subtle signs of (worsening) pain.

Signs of OA include:

- stiffness
- joint swelling
- reduced mobility
- reluctance to work
- lameness
